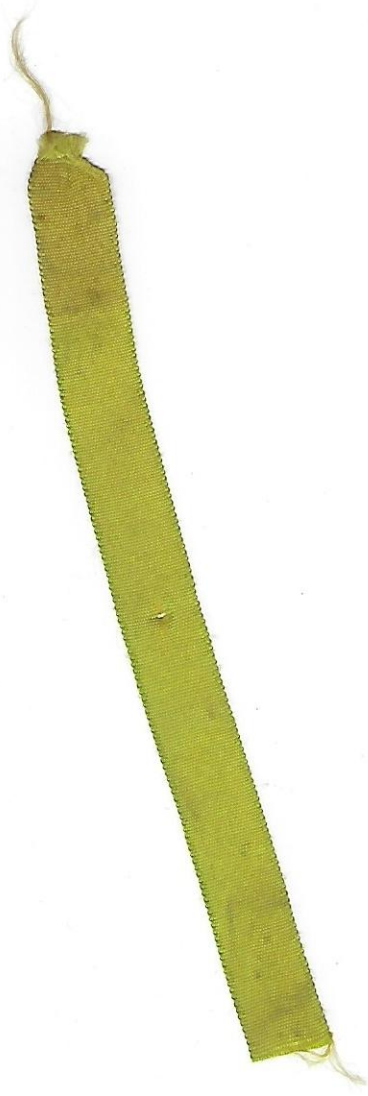

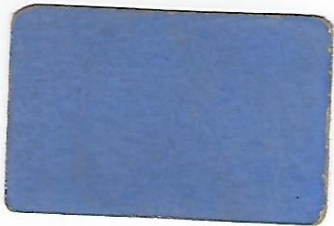

THE FAMOUS BONNET SHOW

Slickaway Church, in Brown County, O., Still Noted for an Old-Time Custom.



THE FAMOUS OLD SLICKAWAY CHURCH.

ABERDEEN, O., March 6.—(Spl.) The Slickaway Church is one of the most noted churches perhaps in the country.

The present structure was built in 1890. Twice before that the church had been washed away by high water from the Three-Mile Creek. The first Slickaway Church was built in 1829, and, with its completion, a novel custom was instituted by the women members of the church. On the third Sunday in May in each year a "bonnet show" takes place at the famous Slickaway Church. Ever since its erection this custom has been carried on. In the first 20 or 30 years of the "bonnet show" steamboats would come to Aberdeen loaded with passengers bound for the

"bonnet show," and to this day people from hundreds of miles around attend. Several times the crowds have been so great it would be almost impossible to get within a quarter of a mile of the church.

On "bonnet show" day the women attire themselves in new head-gear, presumably to show one another the newest styles they wear. The men also appear in their best, but they are secondary to the women with their new bonnets.

The "bonnet show" continues all day long, and is interspersed with music and sermons in the noted church.

The "bonnet show" will occur as usual this year, and a larger attendance than ever before is expected.

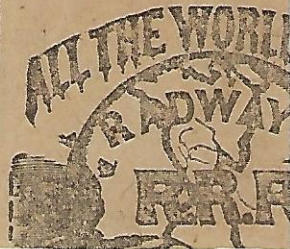
