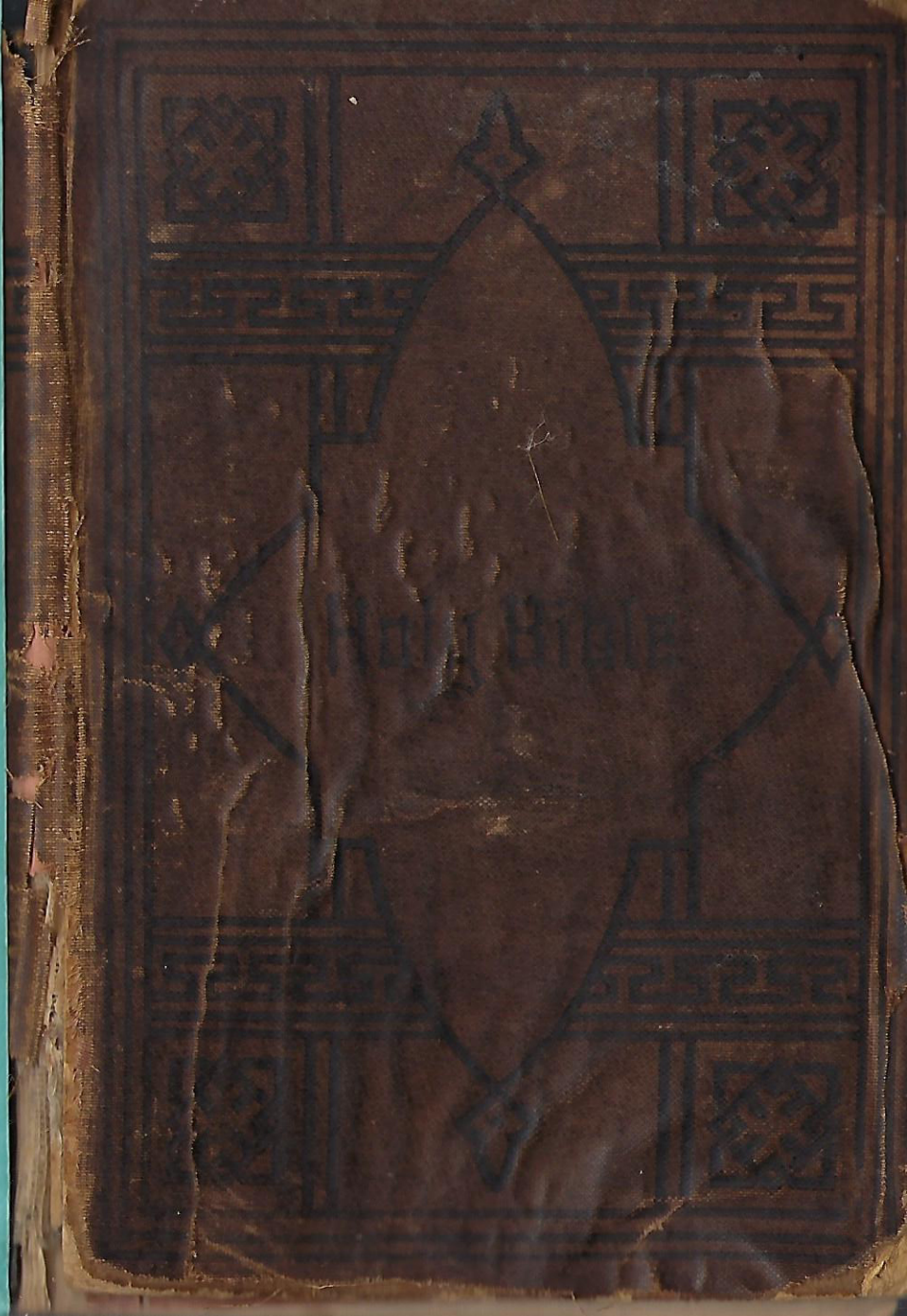

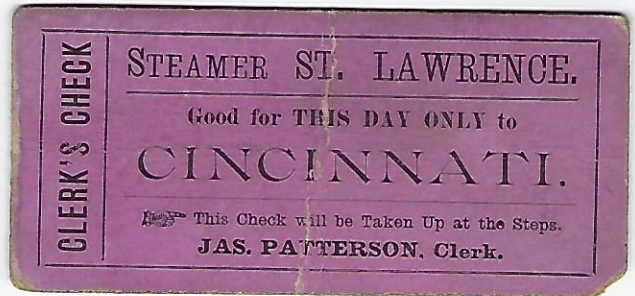

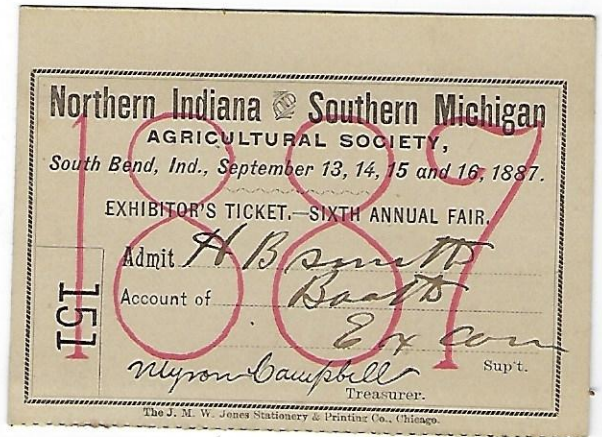
Funeral services from family home on Union Avenue, Sunday, May 25 at 3 o'clock p. m., conducted by Rev. S. W. Brown of the Christian church.
